## **Françoise Meunier, MD, PhD, FRCP – EORTC (Brussels, Belgium)**

Since 1991, Françoise Meunier has –as Director General– managed the EORTC, a major European organisation in oncology with a network of 2500 oncologists in 600 universities and a staff of 200 (17 nationalities). Since 1<sup>st</sup> of April 2015 she serves as Director Special Projects and is responsible for public relations, communications and survivorship program.

She is member of numerous international scientific societies and she has received several awards for her contribution to oncology. In 2007, she was conferred the title of Baroness by His Majesty, The King Albert II of Belgium.

She is a board member of FEAM (Federation of European Academies of Medicine) and “Centre Scientifique de Monaco”, and member of ARMB (Académie Royale de Médecine de Belgique).

In 2015, she was appointed Board member of the Alliance for Biomedical Research in Europe.

In July 2015, she was offered the degree of Doctor of Medical Science (Honoris Causa) by the Senate of Queen’s University Belfast.

Since 2016 she is an active member of the Scientific Panel for Health (SPH).
